

Renewal of Work Stoppage: October 18

- *Renewed suspension of work announced by Jonathan on Friday*
- *Aim is to reinvigorate safety culture at SLAC under the overall theme that "safety comes first"*
 - BABAR is a major part of the lab and a major source of activity, including activity by users
- *Focus is on individual ownership of safety & line accountability*
 - Duration of work stoppage will vary from group to group, depending on the type of work involved and safety readiness
 - Looking for validation of progress towards ownership & accountability
 - Return to work determined by Associate Director based on group's readiness



Renewal of Work Stoppage: October 18

□ *Minimum set of specific tasks*

- Generate ideas and discuss steps that will change the safety culture so that safety always comes first in our particular environment
- Revalidate or complete JHAMs [Job Hazard Analysis and Mitigation] for everyone
- Review required training for currency and comprehensiveness



Routine JHAM preparation

- *Will arrange three sessions to allow individuals or small groups to work through process*
- *Question 1 at today's meeting: "What do you do when you are at SLAC?"*
- *Question 2 for 10am Oct 19: "What can go wrong at these locations?"*
- *Question 3 for 3pm Oct 19: "What can you do to mitigate the identified safety hazards?"*
- *Will then ask for volunteers to prepare sample JHAM(s) based on these discussions & inputs*
 - Possible that there needs to be several types: administrator, physicist, and technical expert physicist



Other Activities

- ❑ *Asking detector systems to also look at their specific job hazards and prepare JHAMs and Area Hazard Analysis [=AHA] for these activities*
- ❑ *Need to prepare AHA for Buildings 48, 280, and IR-2 (management plus other involved parties)*
- ❑ *Training*
 - Everyone needs to take ES&H 239, Electrical Safety Training for Non-Electrical Workers (2-hour course)
 - Considering who would benefit from ES&H course on Electrical Safety in R&D Environments
 - Need to understand how to track and ensure that all users receive appropriate training
