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

- A number of measurements for the STR are laid out in this presentation.


#### Delta Event Time

• Spike at early times indicates retriggers




# Number of retriggers

• Number of consecutive events with delta event times of less than 3000 ticks:




# Number of retriggers

- Log plot shows some events have high number of retriggers
- Number of retriggers is clustered
- Most events have no retriggers




### What is causing the retriggers?

• Plot number of retriggers vs. initial trigger condition



### What retriggers?

• Plot the conditions summary of retriggered events



-> CAL high plus CAL low

# STR plan

- Do the following cosmics runs with 6 towers:
  - Baseline run
  - Turn on CAL reset (was turned off by mistake)
  - Set high energy gain to nominal instead of muon gain
  - Scan through CAL low thresholds: +5, +10, +20, +30
  - Do a run with CAL low triggering disabled at front ends
  - Do a run with TKR triggers disabled
  - Do a charge injection run to establish if we see the effect with charge injection also
  - If this is the case, scan FHE with CI
